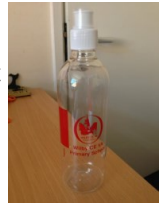

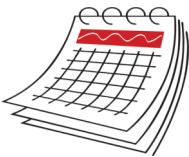
We are still collecting used and broken pens to send to Terracycle.
