What a busy start to 2019 we have had! It was lovely to watch the children complete their karate grading at the start of year following their lessons last term. They all applied what they had been taught in their lessons to the actual grading and it was clear to see the progress they had all made across that term.

One of the highlights of the term was having Radio Northampton visit the school and talk to some children about why they enjoy reading and to hear them read live. All of the children spoke and read so confidently and we enjoyed listening to them.

On the same day, we were visited by Mr Saifullah Nasser from SAfIRE to talk to the children about the Five Pillars of Islam. He was only meant to stay with us for an hour and a half but actually stayed all morning as the children were so enthusiastic and had so many questions. He told us when he left that he was very impressed with the children and their questions and he expected questions like they asked in a Secondary School not a Primary School!

Class 4 had a visit from the Magistrates and acted out a mock trial in a youth court. They all assumed a different role and thoroughly enjoyed the morning. By the end of it, they all decided that defendant was guilty!

Last Friday, we welcomed Jo from Emmanuel Church in Weston Favell Shopping Centre to the school to collect £115 which we raised from MUFTI. Ella, Mrs Lee and myself also delivered a car full of food, bedding and clothes to the Daylight Centre in Wellingborough. Thank you to everyone who donated something on the day. It was very much appreciated.

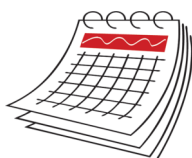
