**IMPORTANT NOTICE**

As we start to look towards the end of the school year and the start of a new year, please could I remind you about uniform expectations as we have seen some slippage this term.

**Winter Uniform**

- White polo shirt or white shirt (With school logo or plain)
- Red sweatshirt / knitted jumper / red cardigan (With school logo or plain)
- Grey full length trousers / Grey skirt or pinafore dress
- White / grey socks or Plain grey or red tights
- Black shoes (no open-toed sandals, flip flops, trainers or boots are allowed to be worn)

**Summer Uniform**

- White polo shirt or white shirt (With school logo or plain)
- Red sweatshirt / knitted jumper / red cardigan (With school logo or plain)
- Grey full length trousers / Grey shorts / Grey skirt or pinafore dress
- Red and white gingham dress
- White / grey socks
- Black shoes (no open-toed sandals, flip flops, trainers or boots are allowed to be worn)

**PE Kit**

It is essential that children have their full, correct PE kit in school each day. A reminder that children should have:

- Plain house coloured T-Shirt (Not white)
- Black shorts (Above the knee)
- Plimsolls or Trainers
- Black Tracksuit (Black Jumper and jogging bottoms - no hooded tops / leggings) (Winter Only)

**Jewellery**

The only jewellery allowed to be worn in school is a wrist watch and one stud earring in each ear. If children are unable to remove their own earrings, please ensure that they do not wear them on days when they will be involved in PE. If your child is having their ears pierced, please arrange for this to happen at the beginning of the summer holidays.

**Hair**

We would ask that hair is checked on a regular basis and treated as necessary as headlice can be a problem at school. We would ask that long hair is tied back and that a simple headband is worn (Ones with ears, unicorn horns, headbands that are worn across the forehead or bandanas are not allowed). We will allow JoJo bows but they need to be small in size. We ask that patterns or logos are not cut into the hair. We would also ask that colour is not applied to the hair.

**Personal Belongings**

All items of clothing and equipment (e.g lunchboxes , uniform etc) should be marked clearly with your child's name. Lost property, which has no visible personal identification, will be held in school for a short time only before being passed on for recycling.

**Wilby Wide Awake Club**

If you would like to book a place for your child, please complete and return the form indicating which dates, With a cheque for the total amount. (number of sessions x £2.50) All sessions for Wide Awake Club need to be booked the evening before so that we can ensure we keep within our ratios.
