Vision

At Wilby CE VA Primary School we are deeply committed to inspiring our children to learn and reach their full potential. Everyone is valued as an individual and helped to develop and progress in their own unique way within a Christian atmosphere.

Principles

It is our policy that all children must have full school uniform, worn correctly, for daily attendance at school. We very much appreciate parents' support in ensuring that the children have the correct uniform and attend school smartly dressed. We regard this as a very important factor in the success of the school.

Aims

Our policy is based on the belief that a school uniform is essential to the ethos of our school community as it establishes a clear sense of identity, fosters a sense of inclusive belonging, and engenders both positive behaviour and self-discipline, which in turn supports teaching and learning.

Uniform

Much of the school uniform can be purchased from most department / chain stores. A reminder that due to Health and Safety, children should only bring in a book bag, PE and lunchbox this year NOT rucksacks.

Winter Uniform

- White polo shirt or white shirt (With school logo or plain)
- Red sweatshirt / knitted jumper / red cardigan (With school logo or plain)
- Grey full length trousers / Grey skirt or pinafore dress
- White socks / Plain grey or red tights
- Black shoes (**no open-toed sandals, flip flops, trainers or boots are allowed to be worn**)

Summer Uniform

- White polo shirt or white shirt (With school logo or plain)
- Red sweatshirt / knitted jumper / red cardigan (With school logo or plain)
- Grey full length trousers / Grey shorts / Grey skirt or pinafore dress
- Red and white gingham dress
- White socks
- Black shoes (**no open-toed sandals, flip flops, trainers or boots are allowed to be worn**)

PE Uniform

Plain house coloured T-Shirt

Black shorts (**Above the knee**)

Plimsolls or Trainers

Black Tracksuit (Black Jumper and jogging bottoms - no hooded top / leggings) (**Winter Only**)

Unless the children have a full kit to change into they will not be able to take part in their PE lessons. A note will be written in their Home: School log on the day informing you that they have not been able to take part.

The only jewellery allowed to be worn in school is a wrist watch and one stud earring in each ear. If children are unable to remove their own earrings, please ensure that they do not wear them on days when they will be involved in PE. If your child is having their ears pierced, please arrange for this to happen at the beginning of the summer holidays.

Hair

We would ask that hair is checked on a regular basis and treated as necessary as headlice can be a problem at school. We would ask that long hair is tied back and that a simple headband is worn (Ones with ears, unicorn horns, headbands that are worn across the forehead or bandanas are not allowed). We will allow JoJo bows but they need to be small in size. We ask that patterns or logos are not cut into the hair. We would also ask that colour is not applied to the hair.

Personal Belongings

All items of clothing and equipment (e.g lunchboxes , uniform etc) should be marked clearly with your child's name. Lost property, which has no visible personal identification, will be held in school for a short time only before being passed on for recycling.

Review

This policy was approved by the Governing Body in Spring 2019 and will be reviewed every year. The next review will take place in Spring 2020.
